Under 18 Policy

We welcome young people to learn at our facility. However, we have a process by which they can progressively become more and more responsible for the training of the dog.

Our policy is that the accompanying adult be in charge of working with the dog the first 3 weeks or so just to make sure all the dogs are safe. The young person definitely can be an important part of the dog's training even if she/he has to wait awhile to be in charge of working with the dog in class.

The adult can help the youngster each week understand what was learned in class.

The youngster can practice with the dog every day. That is the most important part of dog training. Each young person will be taking a lot of the responsibility for the dog's training and then be ready to be in charge of working with the dog in class.

Throughout these few weeks the adult can consult with the instructor about their child working with the dog in class. Gradually the youngster can do more and more training in class. From the beginning the youngster will have time to practice training the dog at home and will increasingly be able to be in charge of working with the dog in class.
